Driver's Rules & Regulations

Please read as there are many changes in the rules

1. **\$25.00 entry fee per car. The driver and crew are still required to pay the Fair gate admission.**
2. All drivers must be at least the age of 18.
3. No one under 16 years of age is allowed in the pits. If underage spectators are found in the pits of the car they are with, they may be disqualified.
4. NO alcohol or drugs will be tolerated; violators will be removed from the premises.
5. Misconduct of a driver, crew, or a friend in the pits, can be the cause for a disqualification of the driver from the event.
6. Drivers are required to wear DOT crash helmets and safety glasses, goggles, or face shield. Drivers are also encouraged to wear fire retardant suits. You must at least wear long sleeves and pants. Proper footwear must be worn with no open toe shoes. Boots are preferred footwear. Drivers must always wear their seatbelt and helmet while they are in the car.
7. Drivers must remain in their car unless given the ok to leave car by track personnel.
8. Only the driver or a predesignated team representative is allowed to talk to an official or Demo Representative. If there is a problem, you must talk with the Demo Representatives.
9. Derby officials may require a driver to remove or change any part or portion of a vehicle which they consider to be unsafe.
10. **Absolutely NO hitting the driver's door.** Officials will determine whether it was accidental. They will also decide if there will be a warning or disqualification. You may not use your driver's door as a shield. It is recommended to paint the driver's doors fluorescent orange.
11. Drivers must hit a live vehicle once every minute. If you are sandbagging, you will get 1 warning. If it continues you will be disqualified. If you are hung on a barrier or other car you may be shut off for safety reasons. Officials may stop the event to remove a vehicle that is resting on top of a barrier if deemed to be unsafe.
12. **All drivers MUST attend a driver's meeting before the demo.**
13. All cars must be through the gate and tech by 7:00PM. Gates will be open at 3:00PM. The order the cars go through tech will determine which heat you are in. However, you will be in heats with compatible cars. When a heat is over, you will be able to work on your car as there is no quarantine.
14. No plastic body cars.
15. If your car's springs are broken, do not weld them. Change them or run them.
16. Only one truck/trailer per pit. You will not be allowed to have a second rig come drop off tools and leave. Must be left at the gate or handed over the fence.

TECH DO'S AND DON'TS

All cars will have to pass tech before all heats, consolation, and features. Tech officials will have a checklist to apply to every car.

1. Your car must be constructional sound, this means: Your car cannot be a rust bucket; it must have solid floorboards, corner post, and other structural areas. No holes in the driver's compartment. Overall, it will be the tech's decision. Patching will only be allowed in the driver's area, adding no structural strength.
2. No Electric Vehicles
3. You may remove solid fans and install electric fans.
4. No altered or welded suspensions.
5. 4. Tires must be stock, no altering allowed- foam, water, chloride, studs, screws, etc. You may use an M & S tire, no pure snow tires. The tread depth may not exceed from the bottom of a penny to the bottom of the building on the back side. This must be anywhere on the tire. Tubes are now allowed. No tires inside another tire. No LT tires.
6. Gas tanks must be removed from the stock position and moved to the rear of the driver's seat. Tanks must be secured to the floor by straps, ratchet straps, etc. It must also be covered with a fire wall, sheet metal, roofing, or other metal. Tanks shall have no more than 3 gallons in them. You can use stock tanks, plastic, or metals, with a firewall. You can use fuel cells if you have the means. No plastic marine tanks or cans with a hose stuck in them.
7. All doors, hoods and trunks must be wired or chained shut, 5/16 chain maximum. No more than 6 wires on hood and 4 on trunk, must be able to be cut with bolt cutters. You can weld or bolt vertical seams between front and rear doors, and rear doors to rear fenders. Not, front doors to front fenders. Any metal used not to exceed 1/8"x2"x2". Only 4 per seam.
8. The hood will have at least a 12-inch by 12-inch hole in the center.
9. You may leave the windshield in, if you remove it, we recommend you install a wire mesh on the driver's side only. It can wrap around the driver's door window also. All other glass must be completely removed, which means no broken glass inside doors. If there is no windshield you must install a bar or chain vertically in the center of the hole.
10. All plastic, chrome, and unneeded cosmetic parts will be removed, including wheel weights, trim pieces, door handles, etc.
11. All antifreeze will be removed and replaced with water only. Please do not bring your car if you have not done this. There will be no draining antifreeze at the fairgrounds.
12. The battery will be moved and secured on the front passenger area. It must be covered but easily accessible. It must be a stock battery, no marine batteries. Do not use wire to fasten the battery. There is only one battery allowed per car.
13. In the pit area you will be required to work safely, for example, use jack stands or tires under cars. Don't use torches near gas tanks. You will have plenty of time to work on the cars. Just slow down and use common sense and we will all have a great derby.
14. Remove all airbags and sensors.
15. No plastic bumpers. Take them off and remove bumper shocks. You may replace it with a compatible bumper, meaning if you have a 4 cylinder car you can only replace it with another 4 cylinder car bumper bolted on and not welded. You may add a safety chain to catch the bumper to prevent loose bumpers falling off on track. Safety only not to reinforce.

16. No hot rodding in the pit area. Keep it at an idle.
17. No Chrysler Imperials, convertibles, hearses, ambulances, Vans, SUVs, or trucks.
18. If you have a car that has been in another demo it will be up to the techs on structural aspects.
19. The driver's door must be padded on the inside.
20. We recommend that all exhaust runs at a downward angle. Headers through the hood if they are safely installed.
21. Cars must have working brakes.
22. You may install modified floor shifters if it is safely done.
23. All fuel lines must be double clamped.
23. Only two spare tires per car in the pit area. You may have more in your truck. If you bring in extra parts, please make sure they leave when done.
24. Covering sunroofs is not required but is recommended.
25. All cars must have working seat belts.
26. You can weld or bolt one bar or pipe from door post to door post behind front seats. It must be 2"x2" maximum steel. No exhaust pipe or any other non-safe material, or you will have to remove it.
27. If you qualify for the feature, you must run your own car, unless the Techs decide that is unsafe. There is much conflict in trading or using other people's cars.
28. No stuffing or altering frames, no foaming the ends of frames.
29. No capping or foaming bumpers. Must be able to see in them.
30. Bumpers: if you change bumpers, they must be bolted on. If you have a 4-cylinder car, the new bumper must be off another 4-cylinder car. No V6 or V8 bumpers allowed on 4-cylinder cars even if you ran it in another derby.

To All That Attend The Demo

******In the past there was some concern about some cars that were cheated up. Remember that your car is supposed to be stock, unless otherwise stated in the rules. If you bring a welded or cheated car and are caught you will need to remove the reinforced areas or you will be disqualified. Not every car or infraction can ever be found, but the tech will be looking. If you take the chance of bringing a cheated car and get caught, remember it was your decision to bring it.

Please remember this is a family event and keep all behavior respectful. We are now a community run event and we want to keep it that way. Don't get mad, we all donate our time, and we are all here to have fun. Thank you.

This year only one person (preferably the driver) will be allowed in the tech area. They don't need an audience. We will also have a tech team walking around looking for smaller things. Anti-freeze, wheel weights, and so on.
